Eastern Slopes Rangeland Seeds Ltd. (ESRS) is pleased to be hosting Plant Identification Course again this year. The course will be held in three components: Forbs, Grasses, and Willows/Sedges. Each component will involve a short classroom session, but will focus on hands-on, field keying and identification using The Common Plants of The Western Rangelands field guides. Field locations include, the ESRS Greenhouse, and a forest reserve west of Cremona, AB. It is possible to attend any combination of days, but attending the first day of the Grass course is highly recommended if attending the second day.

To Align with COVID restrictions the course will be outdoors only and in small groups with no more than 10 people including the instructor with social distancing and all appropriate mitigations in place.

Component 1

June 8 Forbs Cochrane, AB – parkland and foothills species

Component 2

June 9 Grasses Cochrane, AB – prairie and foothills species
June 10 Grasses Cremona, AB – parkland and forested species

Component 3

June 11 Willow/Sedge Cremona, AB – foothills and wetland species
